The Church of the Hills Preschool

The purpose of The Church of the Hills Preschool is to provide a quality social and educational experience in a safe, warm, and loving Christian environment. We believe in educating the whole child. We use a variety of enrichment activities, games, and materials to create an atmosphere which fosters your child's intellectual, social, emotional, physical, cognitive, and spiritual development.

Curriculum:

Children ages twelve months through four years (Pre-K) are taught using a play-based Christian curriculum. Children learn through circle time, play centers, projects, and other special programs offered through the preschool.

Your child will experience *Music and Movement* weekly. This activity incorporates a wonderful mix of songs and activities. The Pre-K classes also learn to play musical bells.

Story Telling is a weekly activity for each class. A storyteller reads to the children using puppets and other animated materials relating to the monthly classroom themes.

The Pre-K classes have the opportunity to learn Spanish once per week with a certified Spanish teacher, while a bi-weekly introductory Spanish class is for the three year olds. The children will be exposed to the Spanish language as they learn basic words and phrases through songs, stories, and play.

A Science class is offered to the Pre-K and three year old classes bi-weekly. In addition to science experiments, the class includes a general overview of plant and animal life, measurement, and weather.

Throughout the year we have special activities such as the Fall Festival, Christmas programs, Donuts with Dad, Muffins with Mom, , Trike-a-thon, visits with Mother Goose, our local fire department, as well as other grade-level events.

Christian Education:

We seek to integrate a spiritual and Christian dimension in all areas of learning. Your child will have a Chapel class weekly. Lessons are taught using Old and New Testament Bible stories, prayer, songs, and games.

Child/Teacher Ratio:

Each class has one lead and one assistant teacher. Class size varies according to the age of the child. Our staff is hired based upon personal training, education and experience.

Non-Refundable Fees:

A registration fee, equal to one month's tuition, is required to register a child. The payment of this non-refundable fee is necessary to secure a space in a class. Registration fees are used to cover the following expenses: administrative, building, and education supplies. There is a \$400.00 cap for registration for families with 2 children, and a \$600.00 cap for families with 3 or more children.

There is an activity fee of \$50.00 for one-year olds; \$60.00 for two and three-year old 2-day students; \$70.00 for two and all three-year old 3-day students; and \$80.00 for three year old 4-day students. Pre-K students carry an activity fee of \$90.00. All fees are due on your child's first day of school.

The above fees will be charged only when your child is enrolled in a class.
